



OpenHackathon Terms and Conditions

Team Registration

- **Team-Only Registration:** Participation is allowed only in teams. Individual registrations are encouraged to join a team. Teams must consist of at least two members and can be formed either through the official Discord channel or independently.

Mandatory Participation

- **Required Attendance:** team members must be physically present at the hackathon venue (Zone01 N.Ionia) during the following hours:
 - Friday, 25 Sept: 10:00 – 18:00
 - Saturday, 26 Sept: 10:00 – 18:00
 - Sunday, 27 Sept: 10:00 – 17:00
- **Final Pitch:** The final pitch to the judging panel is mandatory on Sunday, 27 Sept, at 14:00. Failure to present will result in disqualification from prize eligibility.

Health & Safety

- **Venue Regulations:** Participants must comply with all health and safety regulations of the venue.
- **Personal Responsibility:** Participants are responsible for their own safety and personal belongings.
- **Prohibited Substances:** The use of alcohol, tobacco, or any other substances is strictly prohibited during the event.

Food and Refreshments

- **Food & Beverage Provision:** The organizers will provide snacks, coffee, and drinks throughout the 3-day event. For additional options, teams may bring or purchase their own.

Financial

- **Unpaid Participation:** No financial compensation is provided, except for the prizes awarded to the winning teams.

- **Free Participation:** Participation in the hackathon is free of charge.

Roles & Responsibilities

- **Project Development:** Teams must develop an app / solution aligned with the hackathon's theme
- **Originality:** Projects must be original and must not have been presented elsewhere.
- **Respect & Inclusion:** Any form of discrimination or harassment is strictly prohibited.
- **Collaboration:** Teams are encouraged to collaborate and communicate effectively with mentors, and other teams.

Conduct & Ethics

- **Professionalism & Integrity:** Plagiarism and inappropriate behavior are strictly prohibited.
- **Confidentiality:** Participants must maintain confidentiality regarding shared ideas and project details.

IP & Ownership

- **Project Ownership:** Teams retain full ownership of their projects.
- **Promotion Rights:** Open Hackathon reserve the right to showcase projects for promotional purposes.
- **Respect for Others' IP:** Participants must not use or claim ideas developed by other teams.

Commitment & Termination

- **Alignment with Mission:** Participants must support the spirit and mission of the hackathon.
- **Withdrawal:** Teams that wish to withdraw must notify the organizers in a timely manner.
- **Disqualification:** The organizers reserve the right to disqualify teams in case of violations.

Liability

- **Disclaimer of Liability:** Participants acknowledge that Epirus Bank and Open Hackathon are not responsible for any injuries, losses, or damages arising from the participation.
